The meeting agreed that this would be a very good thing.</li> <li>• The Transport Group were putting all their energies into "Streets for People" events.</li> <li>• The Wind turbine group were preparing a brochure to show examples of good practice (eg in York).</li> <li>• The idea of a Headington-wide action on environmental issues was emerging and proposals would be received by the meeting.
