OUR WAR MEMORIAL RESTORED

Forty-seven families in our community lost sons, husbands and fathers in the Great War. These are commemorated on our War Memorial, which until recently was in danger of collapse.

But, thanks to the generosity of our present community, the Memorial is now being restored, and there will be a Rededication service on Armistice Day 11.11.11.

New wood has been spliced into the existing oak supports, the bronzes are being repaired, repatinated and smart water marked, and there is a new oak shingle roof in the style of the original Memorial. A maintenance schedule, backed by a small reserve fund, will be in place to ensure that the Memorial is safe for at least another century

On behalf of the 47 servicemen commemorated on our War Memorial we thank you for your generous response to the Appeal.
